  - Give a brief reason to explain your choice for each pair

## Tasks

- 2. FOR.** Look at just the 'For' cards. Decide as a group which one you think is the most convincing argument.
  - write a short paragraph to evaluate the strength of the argument.
  - What else would you like to know that would make the case even stronger?
- 3. AGAINST.** Look at the 'Against' cards. Do the same as in task 2
